For over 150 years, the organization's name changed with the needs and times denoting benevolence or aid, ladies and then women, as well as our amalgamation with the St. Francis

Hospital Guild (1926–1945), reflecting our connection and activity with the various communities around Honolulu and our home of Hawai'i.
